Fruity, soft and dry: *Lighter red wines, often called easy drinking. Lots of fruit, rounded finish, warming and smooth.*

Good with or without food, will match most dishes.

Fresh, light, citrus: *Easy drinking, lighter style wines.*

Crisp, elegant citrus fruits with refreshing acidity. Good on their own or with fish, white meats, salads.
